The Government of India formulated the national policy for persons with disabilities in February 2006 which deals with physical, educational and economic rehabilitation of persons with disabilities. In view of this the institute has implemented the policies in the teaching and learning. The policy recognizes that persons with disabilities are valuable human resource for the institution and seeks to create an environment that provides equal opportunities, protection of their rights and full participation in the academic environment.

## **The focus of the policy is on the following:**

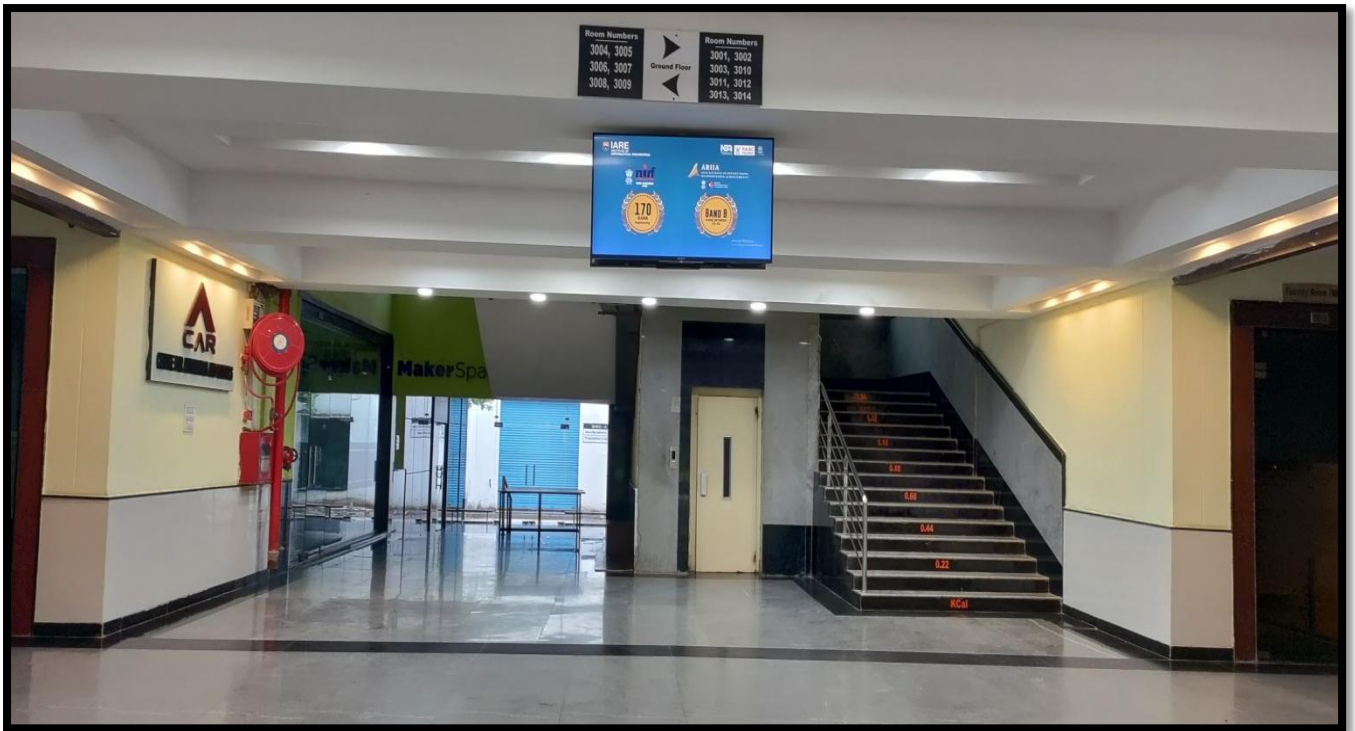
1. To ensure that the design of the building such as ramp/ lift should be construct according to the need of disabled persons.
2. To ensure the accessible, gender-sensitive, safe, usable and functional toilet facilities should be provided for disabled persons.
3. To ensure the proper text and pictogram signage such as tactile path, lights, display boards, signposts are necessary, located to be visible and touchable.
4. Use of signage of male and female symbols, in accordance with local customs and standards, with raised outlines and bright color contrast will be more evident to everyone and particularly helpful for persons with visual impairments.
5. The administrative staff should meet the differently abled student in the classroom or at a spot most convenient for his/her to carry out his/her needs.
6. Learners with disabilities need to be adequately and appropriately supported in and out of the classroom with the right resources, teaching staff and institute communities that are responsive to their needs.
7. To ensure that the accessibility of software tools and technology for the people with disabilities.
8. Provision for enquiry and information like, Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading.
9. No stakeholder should ever discriminate a student belonging to the Divyangjan.
10. A barrier free environment should be provided so that the differently abled students can move about without obstacles anywhere in the campus.
