
Item No. 8 Disposal of Internal answer booklets, Practical files, Seminar, Project reports

Item No. 25 Review the feedback of stakeholders on curriculum, analysis and corrective measures

A summary of feedback, collected from employers on curriculum was presented before the house.

- Feedback on Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcomes, Specific Outcomes is already collected from students, alumni and employers.
- A parent-teacher meeting can be organized once in a semester.
- The house was notified that an on-line mechanism using the institute portal was employed for collecting feedback from students on faculty performance, curriculum and Course Outcomes (COs) for the students.
- The house was informed that on-line feedback on faculty/curriculum and laboratory courses is collected twice during each semester, the data is analysed and corrective actions are taken at the department level.
- It was decided that a comprehensive summary of the feedback analysis will be prepared and put before the house in the next meeting.
- It was also decided that at the end of each semester feedback on faculty performance, curriculum and COs, POs/PSOs will be collected on-line and analyzed.

Resolution: The board noted and approved the action taken report on stakeholder's feedback.

Item No. 26 Review on the initiatives by IQAC and practices to enhance employability, skill enrichment and quality of student projects and participation


- The house reviewed the initiatives of IQAC in enhancing the teaching learning practice.

- More number of industrial projects should be undertaken and ties with local institutions should be strengthened.





















Suggestions made by the members of the Academic Council are:

- Appreciated for the establishment of Centre of learning and Education Technologies.


