ORDER:

In the reference (1) read above, the University has forwarded the proposal to the UGC for grant of Extension of Autonomous Status to Institute of Aeronautical Engineering, Dundigal, Hyderabad, Telangana State.

In the reference (2) read above, the UGC has conferred Extension of Autonomous Status to Institute of Aeronautical Engineering, Dundigal, Hyderabad, Telangana State, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, Telangana, for a period of Five (05) Years from the Academic Year 2022-23 to 2026-27 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018 and requested the University to issue conferment orders as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations 2018 for Autonomous Colleges and subsequent regulations issued from time to time by the University.

Also, the UGC has stated that the autonomy granted colleges shall abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The college shall apply, in the prescribed format to the UGC, for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

Under the circumstances as stated above, the Vice-Chancellor is pleased to approve the conferment of Extension of Autonomous Status to Institute of Aeronautical Engineering, Dundigal, Hyderabad, Telangana State, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, for a period of Five (05) Years from the Academic Year 2022-23 to 2026-27 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate and Executive Council. Further, it is to inform that the College has to follow the autonomous guidelines from time to time as per JNTUH norms.

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the proposal submitted by Institute of Aeronautical Engineering, Dundigal-500 043, Hyderabad, Telangana affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad , for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 17.08.2022, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the autonomous status to **Institute of Aeronautical Engineering, Dundigal-500 043, Hyderabad, Telangana** affiliated to **JNT University Hyderabad** , for a period of Five (05) years from the session 2022-2023 to 2026-2027, as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugu.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.


